



# WOOLWICH



For all its forward vision, Woolwich’s glorious military history gives the town immense character and has left a legacy of handsome listed buildings – most notable at Royal Arsenal Riverside. This former munitions site is now an epicentre of activity, with places to drink, dine and socialise – set against a backdrop of more than 1km of waterside walks and thought-provoking public art.

Complementing the town’s heritage quarter is an established High Street and two revitalised social focal points - General Gordon Square and Beresford Square - with access to green, open space provided by Woolwich Common, Charlton Park, Blackheath Common and Greenwich Park.

Woolwich has experienced an explosion of independently-run bars, restaurants, cafés and shops, adding extra variety to its already thriving hospitality scene. From small and quirky - like The Tap Room Kitchen & Bar - to the unexpected Blue Nile Café Eritrean-Italian restaurant, there are tastes and tipples to be enjoyed from across the globe, with big flavours from Nepal, Taiwan, Tibet and Vietnam making the town’s menus.

Woolwich Works is a brand new cultural hub, café and bar that now provides a home to resident and travelling artistic companies, including the National Youth Jazz Orchestra, Chineke!, dance theatre company Protein and the Punchdrunk performance theatre.

The town is ripe for gastronomic exploration. Grab a bite to eat in The Guard House gastropub, shop for fine French patisseries and bread at Boulangerie Jade, pick up fresh ingredients at Royal Arsenal’s Farmers’ Market or meet friends for drinks on the terrace at Dial Arch.

Woolwich is also well served by big supermarkets and speciality stores, with a High Street packed with popular retail brands and chains stores, and a colourful street market in Beresford Square several times a week.

# ART

Complementing Woolwich's military heritage is the rich naval history just upstream in Greenwich. Visit the Cutty Sark, the National Maritime Museum and the Old Royal Naval College to understand the area's provenance. If you have time, ascend the path in Greenwich Park to the Royal Observatory – a spot from which you can also admire one of the most photographed views of London's skyline.

Art, culture, history and leisure are the four cornerstones of Woolwich's social scene. Drop by artFix – an art gallery and pop-up venue fused with a café and co-working spaces, or catch one of the many live performances that are a regular fixture at The Tramshed community arts centre.

Alternatively, set your own programme and pace. There are ample opportunities to keep mind and body fit in Woolwich, with numerous gyms, sports clubs, walking trails and cycle routes, or follow a fascinating heritage trail around the town at your leisure. Take in the Firepower Museum and the Greenwich Heritage Centre, admire the many listed buildings, and discover why Henry VIII, Elizabeth I and the Duke of Wellington all have indelible links with Woolwich.

Both Greenwich and neighbouring Blackheath are perfect spots for weekend browsing. Greenwich Market is famed for its mix of antiques, collectables and fine food, while the boutiques and independent stores in Blackheath Village offer an alternative to the everyday. For unique entertainment venues, try Blackheath Halls, Greenwich's revered Up The Creek comedy club and the famed O2 Arena.




